

Grades 9-10: For the excellent quality of his social studies presentation.

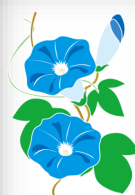
