

School immunization programs

- Immunization News from Your Public Health Nurse
 - Dear Parents/Guardians,

SCHR Public Health Nurses are responsible for immunizing grade 1, 6 and 8 students and will also follow-up when there is a case of a vaccine-preventable disease in a classroom or in a school. To do this work, Public Health Nurses review the student's immunization record in the provincial immunization registry called Panorama. Panorama is a secure electronic health record system designed to store and record immunization-related information. This confidential client information can only be accessed by authorized public health team staff, nurse practitioners and physicians across the province using secure networks. If you have questions about Panorama visit <u>www.ehealthsask.ca/panorama</u> or call your local public health nurse.

During the school year, you will receive correspondence from your local Public Health nurse indicating that your child is due for an age appropriate vaccination:

- Grade 1: review of records to ensure your child is up to date on all preschool vaccinations
- Grade 6: encourage protection against hepatitis B, meningococcal disease, chickenpox and human papillomavirus (HPV for girls only). Please complete the grade 6 immunization consent form and have your child return it to school as soon as possible
- Grade 8: At the beginning of the New Year, Public Health nurses will immunize grade 8 students to boost their protection against tetanus, diphtheria and pertussis (whooping cough). Please complete the grade 8 immunization consent form and have your child return it to school as soon as possible

If you have any questions or concerns about the vaccination program in your school please feel free to contact your local Public Health Nurse.
