


Pangman School Student-led Conferences (SLCs)

Dear Parents:

We are approaching the time for student-Led conferences. The dates for the conferences are Wednesday, November 25, 2020 from 3:45 pm to 7:30 pm and Thursday, November 26, 2020 from 3:45 pm to 7:30 pm. This year these Conferences (like everything else in 2020) are going to look a bit different. We will use Microsoft Teams as the platform for meeting with students and their families.

The SLCs will be held with only the student joining the meeting, and families sitting with them. The student will, of course, log in with their SECPSD account. Some family members, however, may not be physically with the student, and need to be invited separately to the meeting using their private email.

A separate interview time will be determined for each student and their family and a Micro-soft Teams invite will be sent out from the school. However, our teachers will try to accommodate requests for interview times. Please review the date and time schedule that will be emailed to you with the report card and phone the office (442-2051) if you need to re-schedule.

Support Children Support Children

1. Help Others Toward Their Goal

Children can learn they can help others by being a **support system**.

Children can:

- Listen to others work through a problem and support their struggle.
- offer suggestions or observations without doing the work for them.
- Keep someone company as they try a new task and encourage them to keep going.

2. Teach Something They Know

Help your child notice opportunities to share their knowledge, and watch their confidence and compassion soar.

Children can:

- Demonstrate tricky tasks (how to do a math problem, tie a shoe, or read the instructions for a younger sibling or a friend).
- Explain how to do things to help someone else learn.

3. Be There When it Gets Tough

When children support other people, it underlines their knowledge that struggling isn't personal. It's part of the growth. It's not about fixing it — it's about letting someone know they aren't alone and that their feelings aren't too big or unnatural.

Children can

- Use their empathy and compassion to support others when they are
- Support a friend who doesn't make the team, can't get the notes correct, or misses moving to the next reading level by a few points.
