## Students of the Month for September 2020



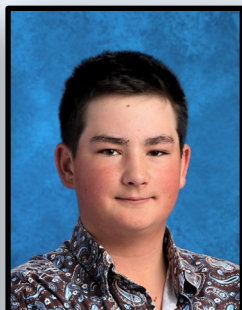
K-3: She is receiving this award for working hard, listening, and for the enthusiasm and effort she puts into learning each day. Great job!



Grades 4-6: She has had excellent attendance and has been on top of all of the work that we have done this month. She works hard and stays on task. Great job!

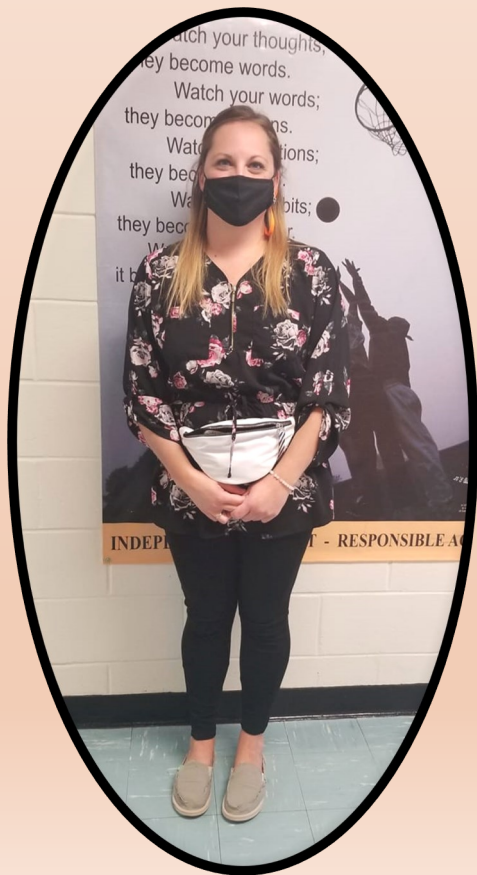


Grades 7-9: For her positive attitude, willingness to participate and good start to the school year. Keep it up!

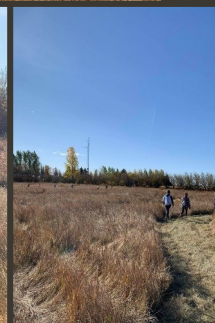
