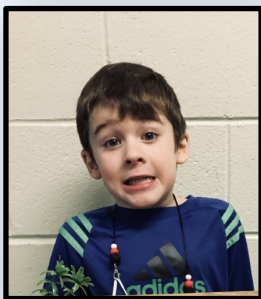

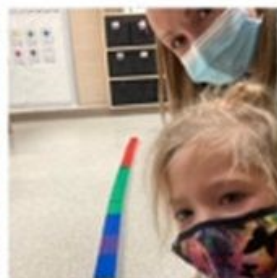


## K-2 Classroom

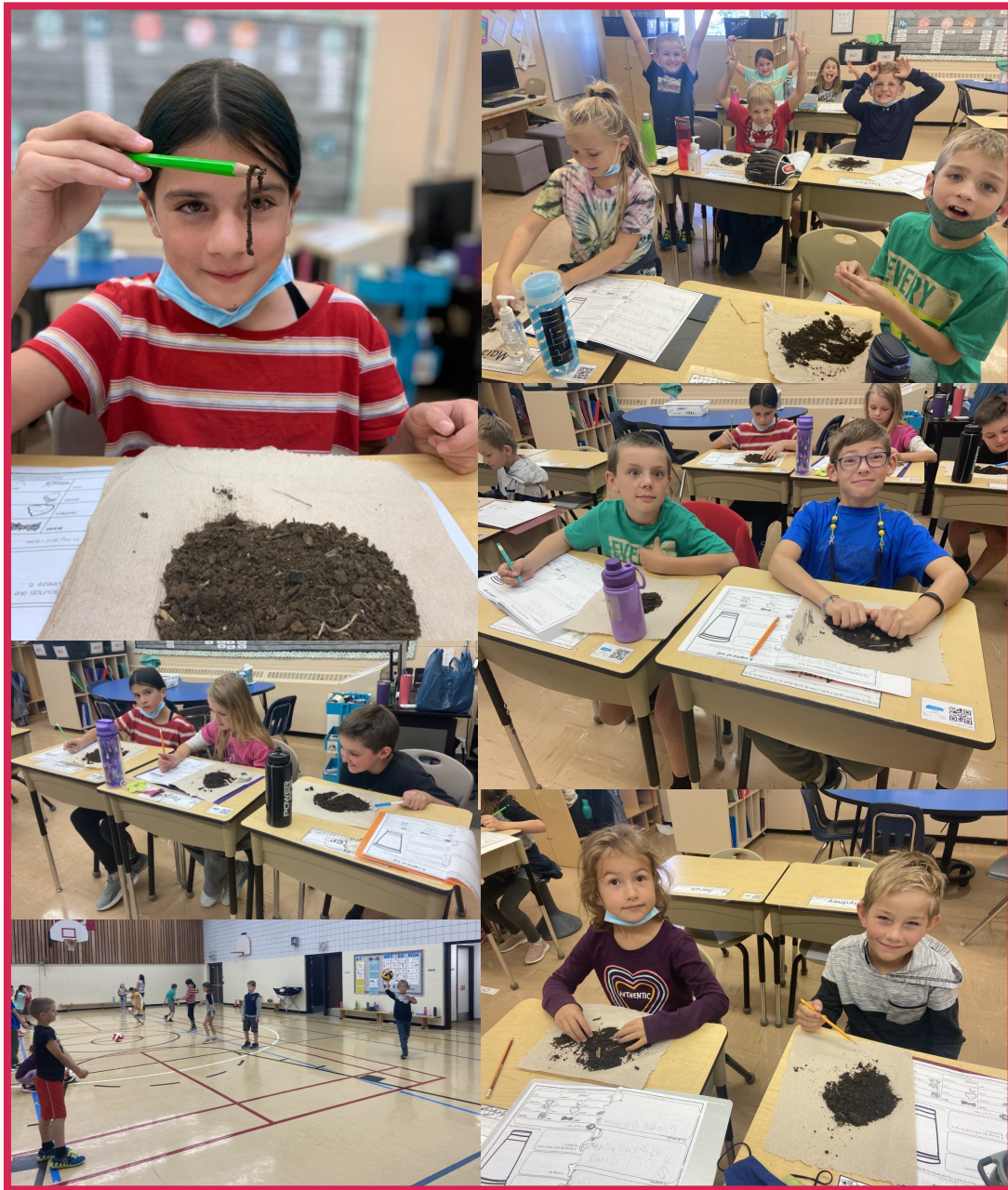
