

SECPSD encourages all families to carefully monitor the content their children and teens access on social media and streaming platforms. We encourage caregivers to speak with their children about program ratings, take advantage of parental control options and explain the potential risks of unintentional exposure to disturbing content. Open communication about shows like "Squid Games" can support children and youth to know what to do when they encounter disturbing content in the future.
