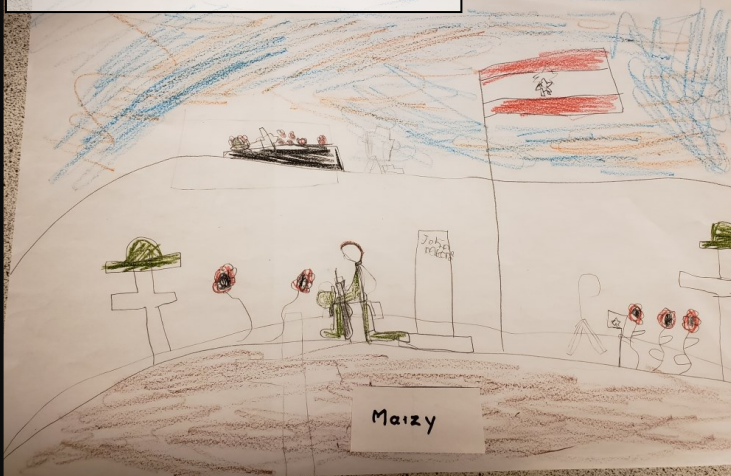

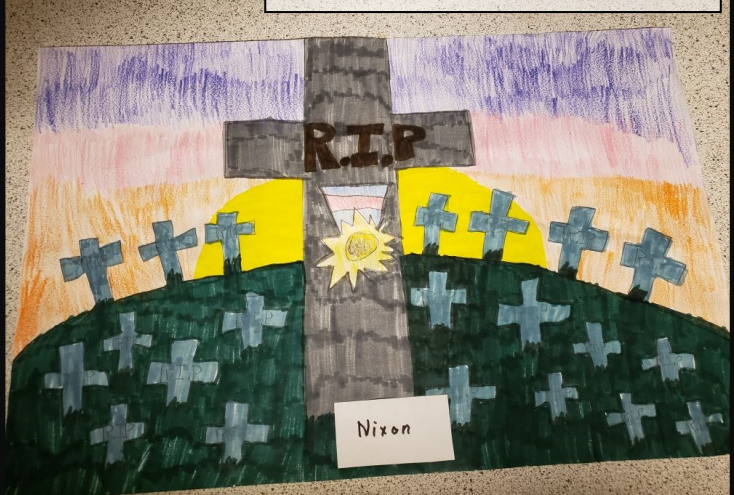

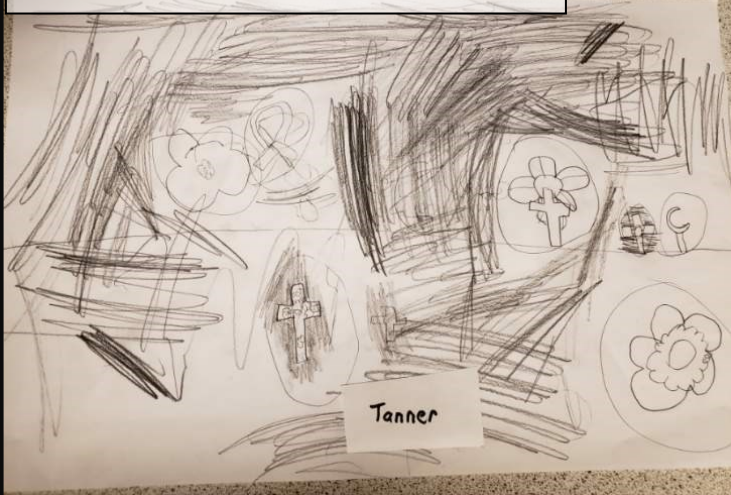

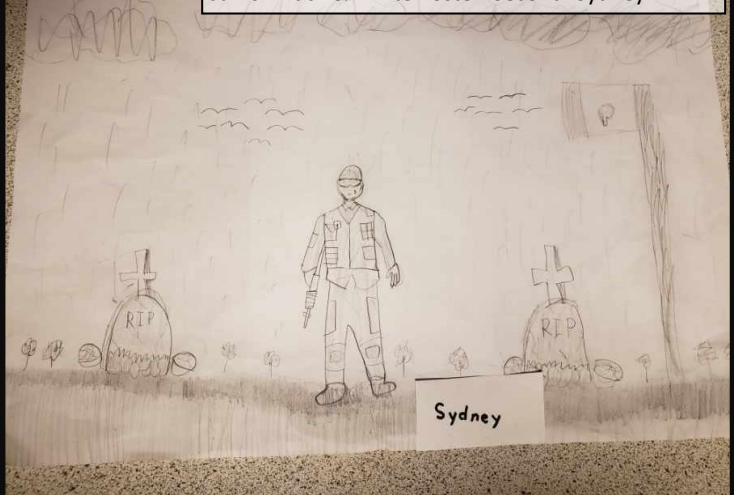

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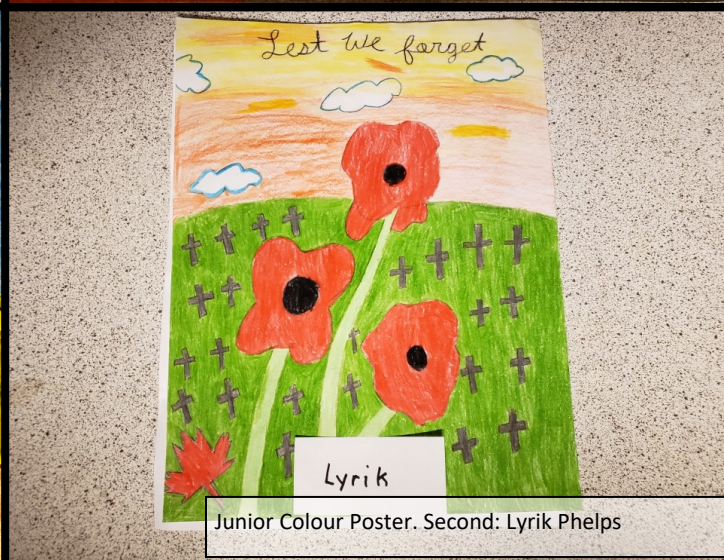

... the Netflix series “*Squid Games*” is trending among youth. Though it’s rated MA (mature adult), it’s represented on platforms popular with kids and teens, like Roblox, YouTube Kids and TikTok. Its aesthetic is colourful and bright, appealing to children. But the show includes themes of suicide, exploitation, violence, and substance abuse, which can be disturbing to young people.

SECPD encourages all families to carefully monitor the content their children and teens access on social media and streaming platforms. We encourage caregivers to speak with their children about program ratings, take advantage of parental control options and explain the potential risks of unintentional exposure to disturbing content. Open communication about shows like “*Squid Games*” can support children and youth to know what to do when they encounter disturbing content in the future.
