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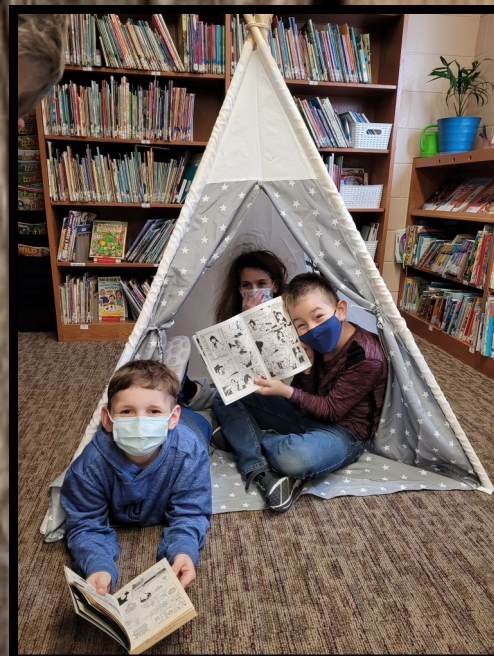

Kindergarten - Grade 2

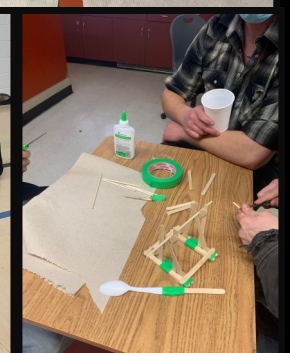
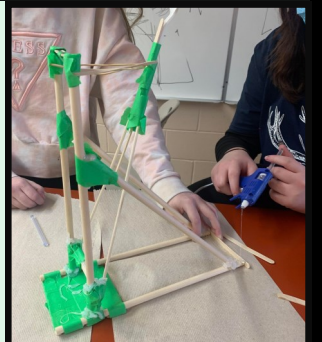
The Kindergarten, grade one and grade two students have been learning about the five senses. In this activity the students had to guess what they were eating without using their sense of sight.

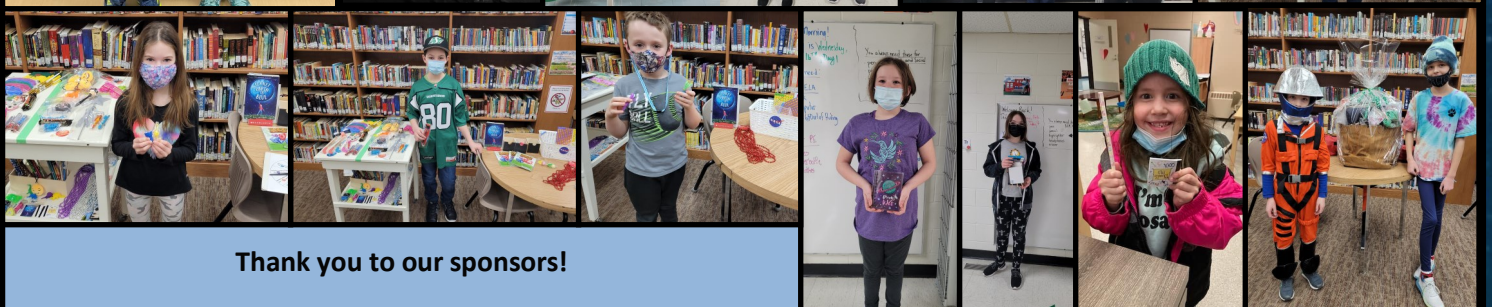
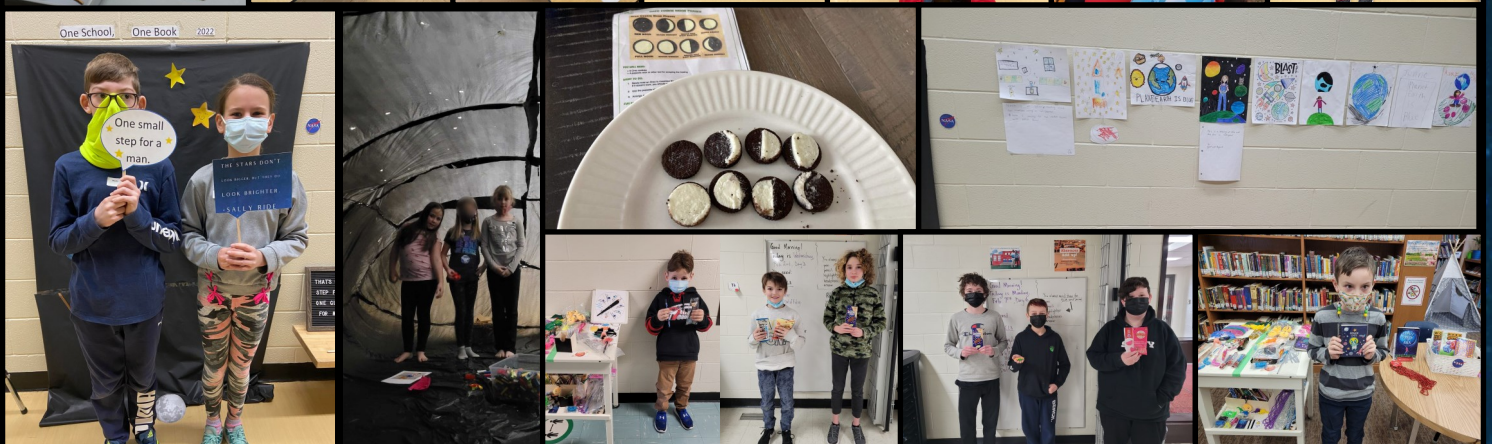
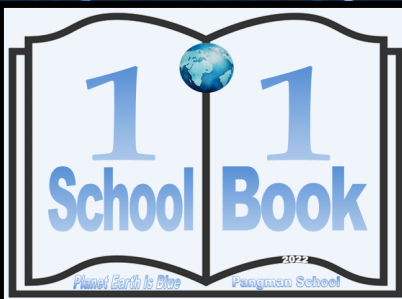


Classroom Activities
