SCC Spotlight

April's School Community Council (SCC) Spotlight features Cacey Warren. Cacey has been a member of the SCC since 2020. Cacey and family live just south of Pangman on an acreage they purchased almost five years ago. Cacey and her husband are originally from Ontario. They have one daughter in Grade 2 at Pangman School. Cacey sists on the Pangman Library Board and is the Facility Manager of Deep South Personal Care Home here in Pangman. We interviewed Cacey to learn about her and why being a member of the SCC is important to her.

Pangman School: Cacey, what made you decide to become a member of the SCC?

Cacey: I was actively recruited by other current members. Once my daughter started school, it only made sense to me to join and be a part of helping the school.

Pangman School: What is the SCC and what does the group do?

Cacey: The SCC is the School Community Council. The SCC does a lot of brainstorming, planning and fundraising to give the school and students things that are not within a rural schools budget. In the past the SCC has purchased new projectors for classrooms, expanded the playground by putting new play equipment, put on hot lunch days and held/sponsored many "fun" days for the students. We are all looking forward to being more hands-on in the future now that pandemic restrictions are easing!

Pangman School: What's something you would like to see the SCC do in the future?

Cacey: An on-going discussion has been a basketball court. That would be one of the bigger goals the SCC has and would like to make a reality!

Pangman School: Why is the SCC so valuable for our school?

Cacey: The SCC is valuable to our school in many ways. As noted above, to allow us to raise funds to give the school and students more than the school budget allows. But it's also great for us parents. We get to have a more in-depth relationship with the school our child(ren) attend and get to see the smiles on our child(ren's) faces when they enjoy something the SCC planned or purchased!

Pangman School: What would you say to other parents who are considering becoming a member of Pangman School's SCC?

Cacey: Honestly, it's the least stressful/easiest group I've been on so far and I'm glad I joined. It's a wonderful group of people working towards the same goals!


