


Edsby Notifications


Instructions for Parents and Caregivers

When you log into your Edsby account, you have the ability to turn on or change your Edsby notifications. These settings can be changed at any time and additional notifications can be enabled as outlined below.


1 Within the Edsby App select the "Settings" button under the profile name.




2 Click "Notifications" to access your notifications overview. Here you can customize the listed items.



3 Select the boxes to indicate where you want to receive notifications. Click "Apply changed to all my children" if needed.



4 For mobile devices, ensure notifications are enabled for the Edsby App. This can be accessed in the general settings of the device you are accessing Edsby on.



Notification settings, set on the computer browser, will carry over to the user's mobile device, provided you have enabled push notification for the Edsby App. **Please Note:** Some Edsby notifications do not result in a pop-up notification, there is no way to control how the end users' devices are set up.
