

Dear Parents, Guardians and Students,

Printed immunization records will no longer be mailed home on a routine basis at the end of Grade 8.

Immunization records are available for viewing and printing in the student's MySaskHealthRecord online application account at https://www.ehealthsask.ca/MySaskHealthRecord/MySaskHealthRecord.

- If a student aged 13 years old or younger does not have an account, a MySaskHealthRecord account must be created for them by following the directions at the link above.
 - Parents/guardians <u>must have</u> their own MySaskHealthRecord account to request access to their child's health information in MySaskHealthRecord. Your child's information will be directly linked to your account.
- Students 14 years and older must create their own confidential MySaskHealthRecord account at the link above.

If you choose to not sign up for MySaskHealthRecord, you may contact your local public health office to inquire about receiving:

- An emailed copy of the student's immunization record; or
- A printed immunization record if self-printing is not possible.
- A fee may be applied to these services.



This falls short of addressing increases and costs related to: support staff collective agreements, teacher salary increments, local agreements, statutory benefits, fuel, insurance, utilities, general inflation, and continuing need for specialized student programming.



*the graphs below illustrate the operating grants received by SECPSD over the past 9 years and The Cost of Living Adjustment (COLA) increases.





What does this mean for SECPSD?



- Classroom teacher staffing will be at a ratio of 1 teacher for every 23 students
- A reduction in central office staff supporting teachers and students
- Fewer programs and unique learning experiences for all students
- Reduction to non-personnel related purchases
- · Another substantial deficit budget



SECPSD has submitted a deficit budget since 2015 to limit reductions, but public education in Saskatchewan needs sufficient, sustainable funding.
